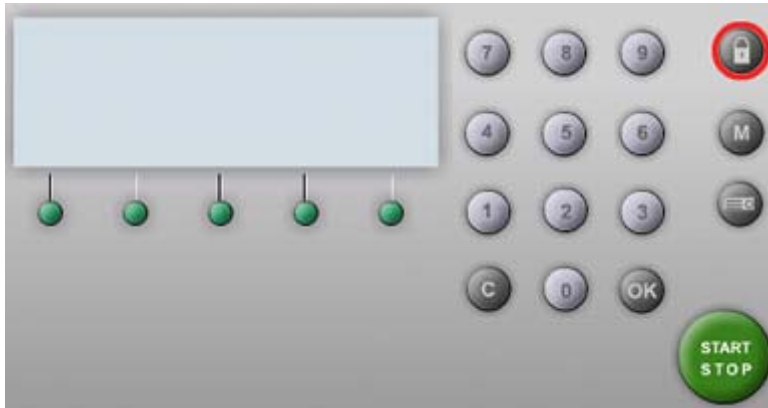

WJ135, WJ180, WJ215 – January 2011 USPS Rate Change – Loading Rates

To install the January 2011 USPS Rate Change on the WJ135, WJ180, WJ215:

1. Press the **LOCK** button.



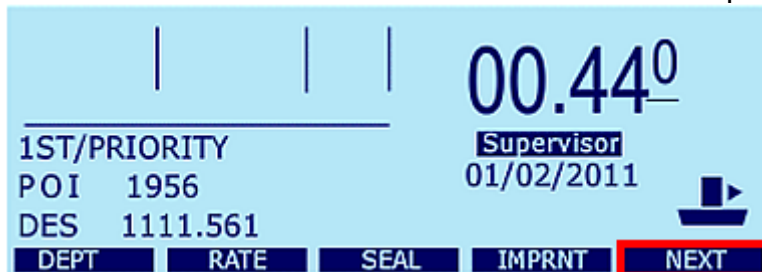
2. Press the button below **SUPERV**.



3. Enter the Supervisor Pin Number, **9430**. Press the **OK** button.



4. Press the button below **NEXT** until **SETUP** is displayed.

5. Press the button below **SETUP**.

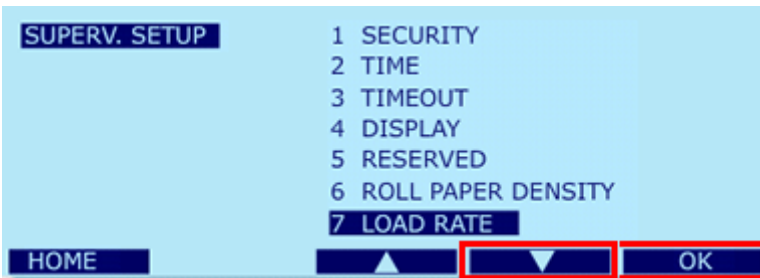


6. Using the down arrow, select **Option 7, LOAD RATE**.

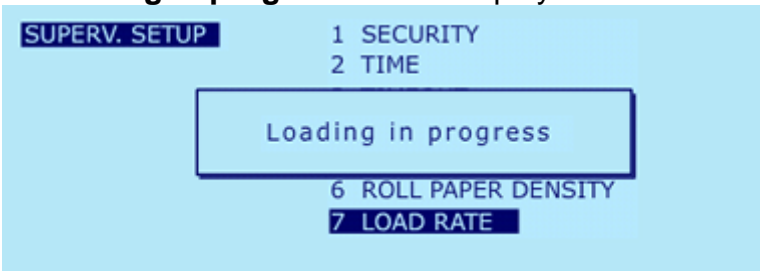
- Insert the rate card with the model number facing up into the slot on the side of the mailing machine.

- If the rate card is not inserted properly, the following error message will be displayed: **"E102 Waiting for memory card, insert and retry."**

- Press the **OK** button.

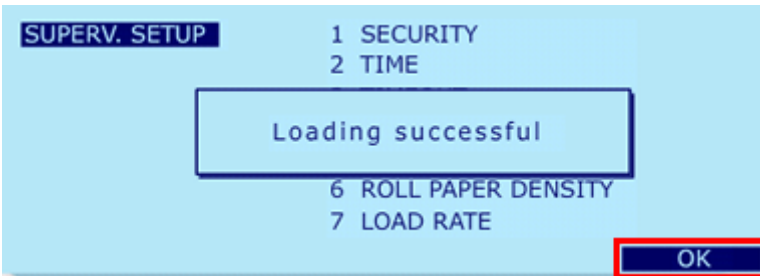


7. **Loading in progress** will be displayed.



8. Once the new rates have been loaded, **Loading successful** will be displayed.

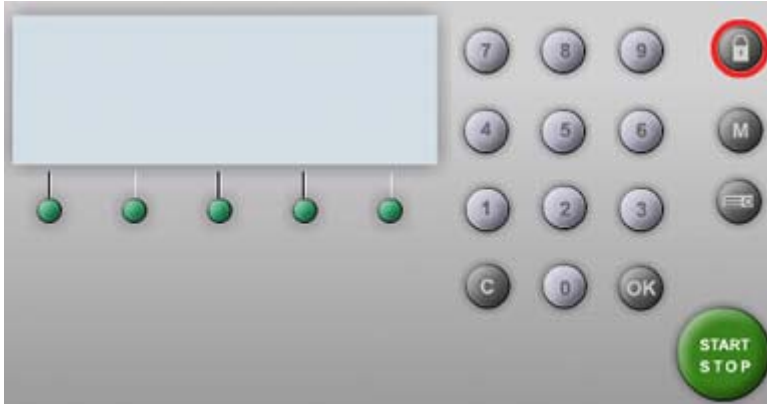
- Press the **OK** button.

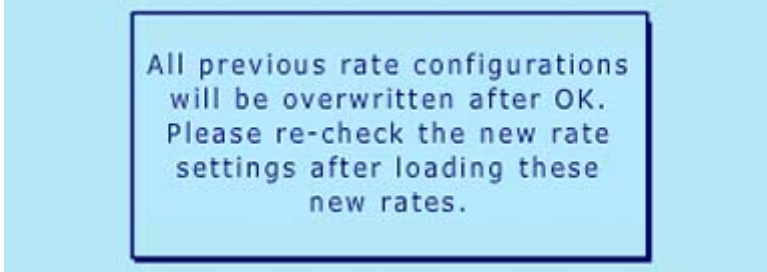
9. Remove the rate card.

- Press the **LOCK** button to return to the main screen.



10. The new rates will not become active until the USPS effective date of January 2, 2011.

- On the effective rate change date, the screen will display:



- Select **OK** after this statement. If you do not, the new rates will not become active.

11. Load the new rates only once.

- Loading the rates more than once will delete the current rates.
- If you have any questions, please wait until the rate change date to reload the rates.
